*David Mathis said this about the meaning behind Matt Redman's song "The Heart Of Worship". The heart of worship is our heart, delighting in Jesus and expressing praise to him for the true things the Scriptures teach us about who he is and what he has accomplished for us. It is, then, "all about" Jesus, not us. It involves us, but we're at the periphery. He's at the center. He's the focus. It's his commands we consider first, not our preferences. Redman's song is about refocusing, and re-centering, and reminding ourselves why we worship - and who we worship.*
