4. What are children learning from us and do they need to learn in how to navigate a pandemic world and not be pushed away from eternity in the process?
5. "Knowledge puffs up but love builds up"...how can you see this possibly playing out on an upcoming Sunday morning as we re-open the church? How can you model focusing on our similarities/commonalities and not our differences? How would Satan win if our failure to do so resulted in division?
6. How do we allow God to be in control of the details of assembling in healthy, recommended ways and we just show up and offer ourselves for Him?
