3. How do we help our children see that divisions in church ( among people anywhere ) are not healthy, not new, and can be overcome for their faith journey to thrive?
4. There are many areas of the re-opening guidelines that people might disagree with. Would it be easy to judge someone for a differing viewpoint? How do we guard against this? Does Satan get a foothold in our lives if such division takes place? What could that look like? How does Christ's message of unity apply?
5. Paul wrote the 13th chapter of 1 Corinthians to the church at Corinth not for a marriage ceremony  . If we read this chapter with the re-opening of FMC and the CDC guidelines in mind, what does Paul's advice say to us during this time in our lives? Does it take on a slightly different meaning than when we use it at a wedding?
