

Small Group Questions

1. Pastor Joel started his message with a series of simple questions: What does it mean to be the church? What if the church building was gone? Would it survive? Any responses to these questions?
2. Why do we seem to be put so much importance on the church building in our world today? Why do we focus on the building more than the actual church body?
3. In the first of two key points of "what does God desire the Church to look like", seeking God's advice through prayer rose to the top. Do we do that as often as we say we do or as often as we should? Or do we seek his affirmation of a direction we have decided to go without consulting him?
4. Why do we struggle with prayer so much? What seems to hinder us? How can we move forward?
5. Looking to the Scriptures was the second key point found in the NT Church in Acts. How frequently are we going to God's Word for guidance and direction? When we find that direction, are we applying it to our lives? Why or why not?
6. What is the one thing you are looking forward to the most about coming back to the building to worship together?
