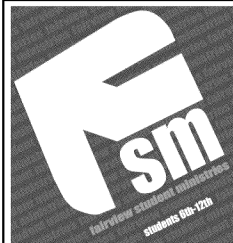

Air Scrubber We have installed an air purification system in our air handlers that uses UV lights to filter our air. Our system is the same system they use at Lutheran Hospital in Ft. Wayne. Studies have shown an average 99% reduction of microbes/contaminants in less than 24 hours after use. We are doing everything we can to keep you as healthy as possible.

Fairview Kids The Kids Ministry area of Fairview Missionary Church will be remodeled later this year.
